About Ananthapuramu

Ananthapuramu, situated along National Highway 7 in Andhra Pradesh, holds historical significance as the headquarters of Datta Mandalam, which comprised the Rayalaseema districts of Andhra Pradesh and Bellary district of Karnataka, in 1799. During the Second World War, it served as a key strategic location for the British Indian Army Conveniently located just 180 km from Bengaluru International Airport, Ananthapuramu is less than a three-hour drive away.

Once considered a backward district in the Ceded region, Ananthapuramu has transformed into a thriving city postindependence, now home to a population of about five lakhs. It has become a prominent center for education, boasting esteemed institutions such as Sri Krishnadevaraya University, JNTU Anantapur, Sri Sathya Sai University, Central University of Andhra Pradesh, Government Medical College, and PVKK Institute of Technology.

Recently, the district was bifurcated, giving rise to Sri Sathya Sai district, with Puttaparthi as its headquarters. The region is rich with attractions, offering a mix of historical landmarks and spiritual sites.

You can explore ancient forts in Gooty, Penukonda, and Rayadurgam, which once belonged to the Vijayanagara Empire, or visit the famous Thimmanna Marrimanu, the largest banyan tree in the world with a canopy covering 4.72 acres, recognized in the Guinness Book of World Records. Pilgrimage spots like Kadiri and Lepakshi add further cultural depth to the region, while Sri Sathya Sai Nilayam, a globally renowned spiritual center, draws devotees from near and far. The ISKCON temple and the Hanuman temple at Mounagiri are other notable spiritual landmarks. Ananthapuramu is also known for its unique local cuisine, which is rich and nutritious, offering a taste of Rayalaseemás distinct flavors. The district is a fruit paradise, famous for its pomegranates, guavas, mangoes, and plantains. In addition, figs (Anjuram), a fruit originally from Israel, are cultivated in various mandals such as Kanekal, Bommanahalli, Kalyandurgam, Rayadurgam, and Garladinne, providing a unique culinary experience.

We warmly invite you to explore Ananthapuramu, not just for the academic enrichment, but for the diverse experiences it offers. Plan your visit early to enjoy its historical sites, indulge in its local delicacies, and immerse yourself in a well-rounded experience.

For the first time in Andhra Pradesh, we are organizing a two-day CME for practitioners, beginning Saturday afternoon and concluding Sunday afternoon. This format will allow you to blend learning with leisure, without overwhelming the mind.

Ananthapuramu is well connected by both road and rail across Andhra Pradesh, and though situated at the southwestern tip of the state, it's easily accessible via Bengaluru International Airport.


